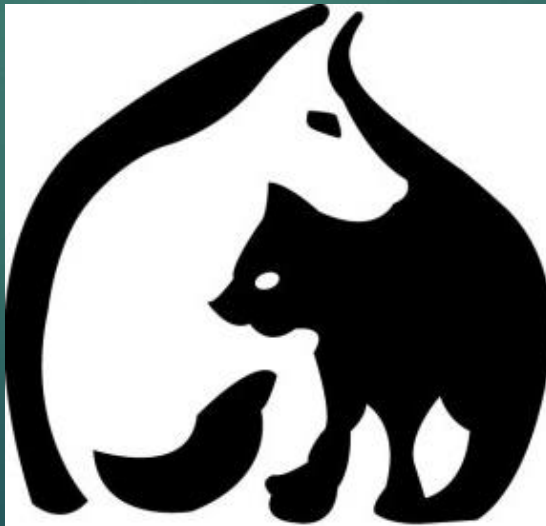

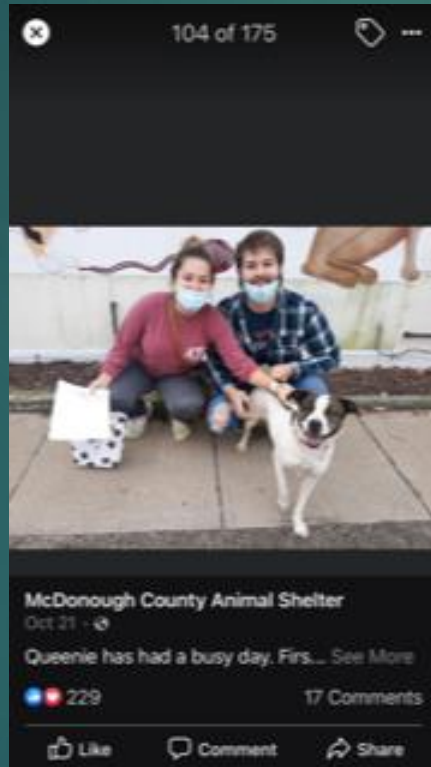

We contribute \$35 toward spay/neuter of each animal at the shelter.

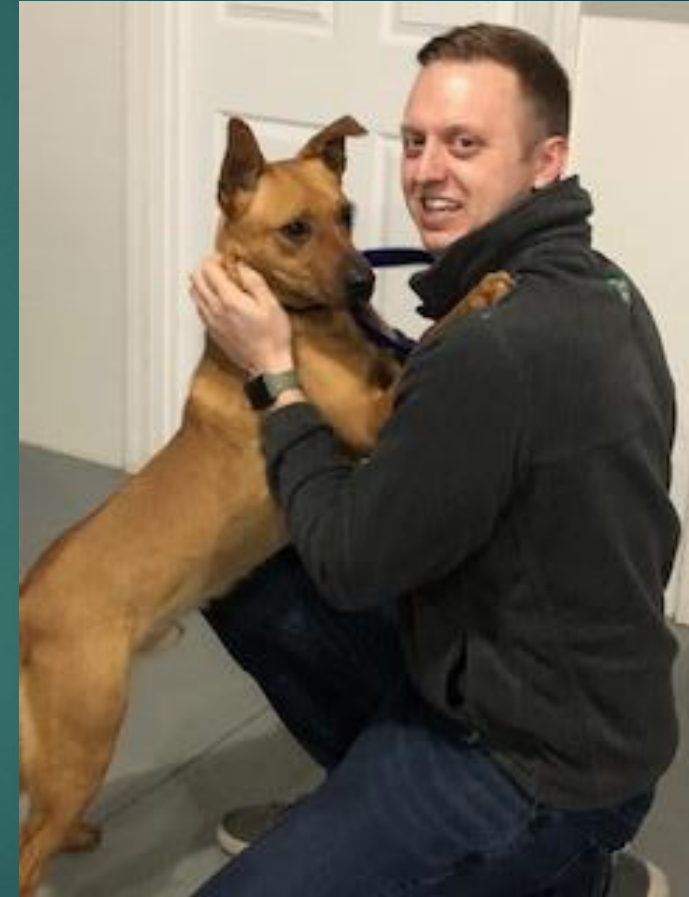

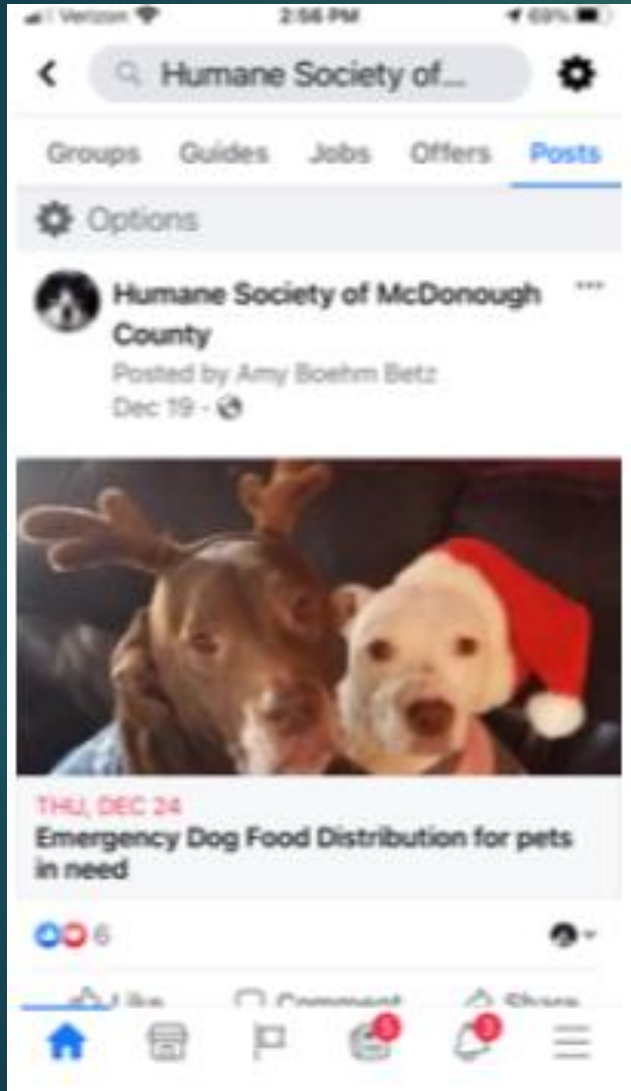
Emergency Assistance – Angel Fund

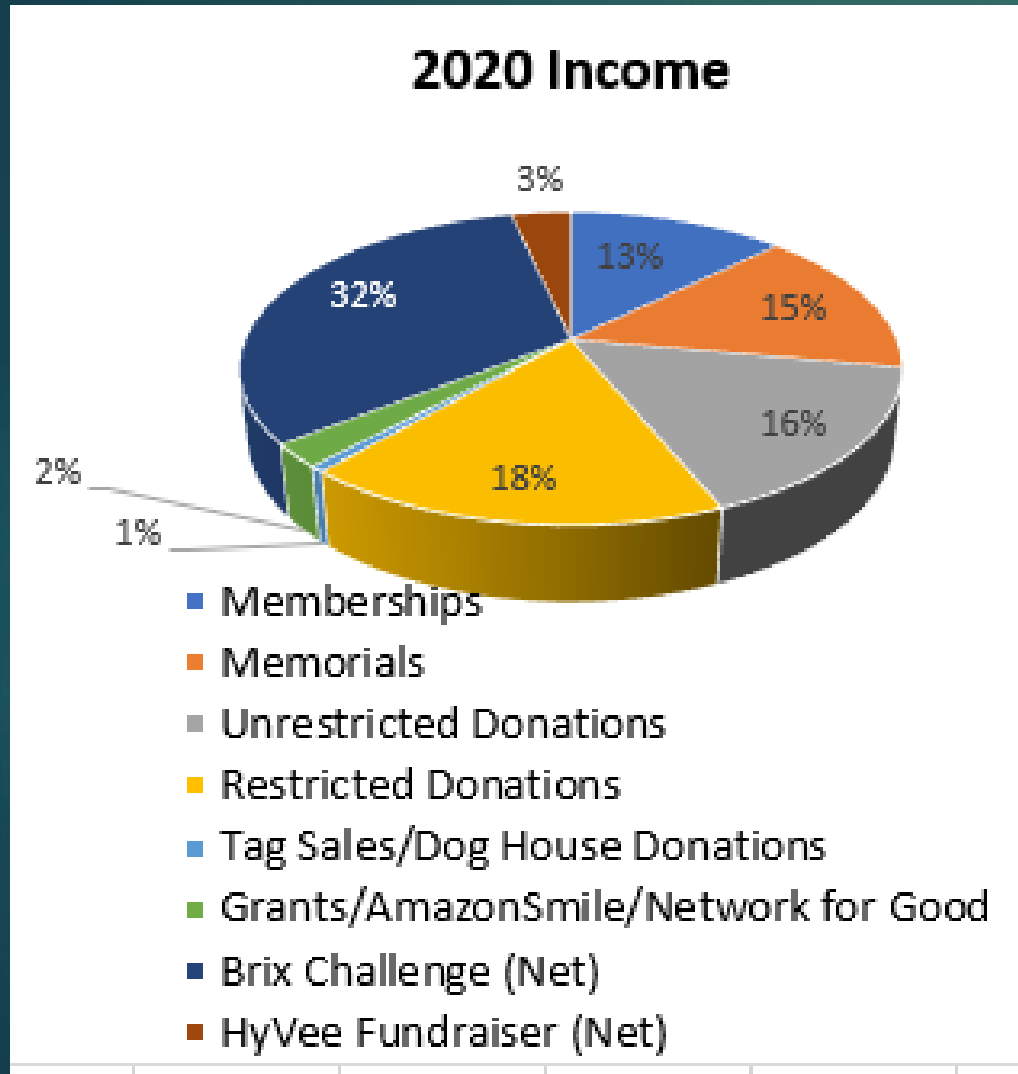

Memorials were given for HSMC initiatives and the new shelter campaign.

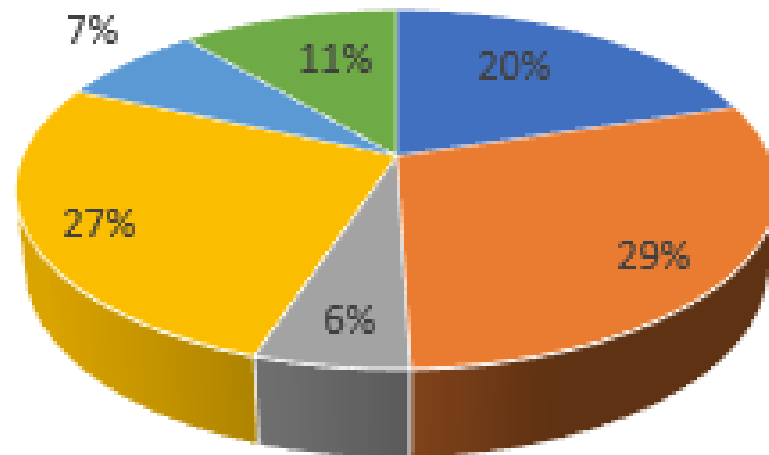

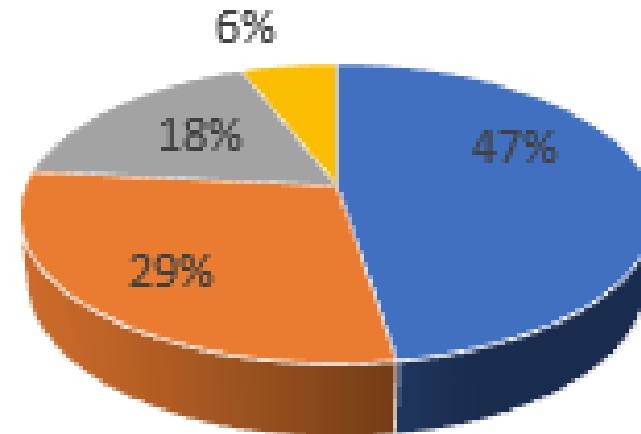
